The Canadian Association for Medical Education (CAME) endorses principles regarding industry funding of medical education contained in AAMC report.

The Board of Directors of the Canadian Association for Medical Education, in a recent vote, has endorsed in principle the AAMC document, 'Industry funding of medical education'. Acknowledging the dynamic, complex and important relationship between industry and academic medicine, the CAME Board of Directors recommends further work in adapting the recommendations of the report to the Canadian context and calls for continued collaboration between academic institutions and governments to further develop sustained, professionally responsible funding models for the delivery and advancement of all aspects of medical education.

CAME is a grass-roots organization *for* medical educators *by* medical educators. Our goal is to promote excellence and scholarship in all aspects of medical education by advocating for medical education and medical educators, by supporting faculty and educational development, and by encouraging research in medical education through networking and scientific activities.
