- Identify their professional goals as leaders in the health professions and discuss ways of achieving these goals
- Analyze their own leadership styles as well as others' styles and consider how style influences practice, using different models of leadership and change
- Apply a framework for analyzing change to specific situations in their own professional contexts
- Master different conflict management styles and negotiation strategies
- Describe an approach to establishing and leading effective teams
- Define "scholarship" with respect to medical education and discuss strategies to foster scholarly work

The Institute is geared towards health professional educators who are in a position to implement new skills in the workplace.
