Title: Use the Fundamental Teaching Activities Framework to make the

most of your teacher evaluation!

Presenter: Dr. Marion Dove

Biography: Dr. Marion Dove, Associate Professor in the Department of Family Medicine at McGill University, has been the Director of Postgraduate Education (Residency Program) since November 1, 2015. She was the Director of the Faculty Development Committee from July 2009 to November 2015 and a member of the Faculty Development Working Group of the College of Family Physicians of Canada between 2012 and 2016. Dr. Dove holds a medical degree from McMaster University (1994) and did her residency in family

medicine at McGill University (1996). Her family practice at the CLSC Côte-des-Neiges includes obstetrics with deliveries at the Jewish General Hospital. From 2003 to 2005, she practised at the Centre de Santé de la Basse-Côte-Nord in Blanc Sablon.

Overview: Every year, clinical teachers receive feedback from their residents and externs. However, they rarely use these evaluations to truly change the way they teach or provide clinical supervision. After taking part in this workshop, you will never look at your teacher evaluations the same way!

Using guided exercises and short presentations, this workshop will explore the typical psychological reactions to feedback and demonstrate how the Fundamental Teaching Activities (FTA) Framework developed by the College of Family Physicians of Canada can be used to analyze one's annual teacher evaluation and draw useful solutions from it.

Objectives

By the end of the workshop, participants will be able to:

- Recognize common emotional and intellectual reactions to feedback from learners
- Analyze this feedback to identify his or her personal strengths and those of the team
- Use the Fundamental Teaching Activities (FTA) Framework to plan how to follow up on teacher evaluations by learners
